Open Enrollment 2025

Executive directors and HR managers: HBP's annual open enrollment runs from November 3rd through December 1st this year. Communications were emailed on Monday. During the Open Enrollment period, employees may make changes to their benefit elec-

tions for the upcoming plan year. Employees making changes will need to complete an "Enrollment & Change" form and mark "Open Enrollment" next to the reason for their changes. Completed forms may be sent by email to HBP@vimly.com by December 1st. You may also enter changes directly into the Vimly enrollment site at: www.SIMON365.com. If your housing authority or employees are not making any changes, you are not required to submit open enrollment documents.
